From the Public:

Clerk's Report: Nancy Walter

Review November 16, 2021 minutes, motion by Trustee Thurston to approve with a 2nd from Trustee O'Hara. All ayes.

Presented resolution identifying the polling place and hours for the March election. Motion was made by Trustee Boyd, with a second by Trustee Cornell to adopt the resolution, all ayes. Asked the Board if they know anyone interested in being an election inspector, we have one, but we need a second.

<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Jennifer Schenck emailed everything to the Board members. Jenn said this is a quiet time of year for the Village and everything is in good shape.

Went over November financials and current boat launch revenue. Had budget modifications for the month. Motion to accept modifications was made by Trustee Thurston, with 2nd by Trustee O'Hara. All ayes.

Audit of Bills: Abstract #7

General Fund: Vouchers #288-323 \$26,419.77 Water Fund: Vouchers #291-324 \$12,035.78 Sewer Fund: Vouchers #294-323 \$30,969.86

Donna asked about for an update on Joe & Nick's water licenses. Bud told her where they are at and that Bob Kneaskern will still be on retainer until the end of May, will revisit when we do the budget. Motion to pay the bills was made by Trustee Cornell and 2nd by Trustee Thurston. All Ayes, passed.

Department of Public Works: Kevin Thurston

Kevin told the Board that they are working with Auctions International to get a few things listed with them to sell. The DPW has taken the fountain out of the mill pond for the winter. They have had to salt a few times and everything went smoothly. He also mentioned the electric gate that was installed at the DPW very seldom works and it has never been right. Not sure what kind of recourse the Village would have, may get information to Chad and see what can be done.

They hope to get the new pump in at the pumpstation tomorrow. They had a call this morning about bricks falling from antique shop on Main Street. Bud called to get information on who to talk to as it is still tied up in court as the owner passed away. He did find out that the Executor has not yet been appointed. Bud was able to speak to the Attorney and he told him that the Village cannot leave the sidewalk blocked off and that it is a liability. He said he would send a stone mason out to look at it.

Bud talked about a new truck, it may take a year to get a new one.

Code Enforcement Officer Report: Kevin Thurston

Kevin told the Board that Cayuga County 239 denied CIN plans for the new BINGO Hall as it is missing SWPP, the builder says that they don't need one and he is going to call his engineer. Asked if they could have permit issued to begin work, Kevin told them no as it was not approved by 239.

Mayor's Report: Bud Shattuck

NYS Grants – boat launch- This contract was signed and sent back, then they asked for more information that was sent last Friday, we are hoping it goes right through and we get our money to pay on the RAN.

- **Streetscape-** Final design draft is in, we are waiting for subcontractors and DOT as they change their minds often.

Solar-Had a call from Melissa at Abundant solar in regard to solar at the pumphouse property. Financing is in place and they are hoping to begin in 2nd quarter of 2022. Want to extend the contract from 25 years to 30 years.

NYPA-LED lights all in, one is not working on Center Street. Brian has had training, Joe & Nick will get with Brian for some training.

B&L-WWTP-Fiscal Advisors-Bud had webinar with B&L and Fiscal Advisors in regard to WQIP & WIIA grants for WWTP. We have a contract with Fiscal Advisors to bond \$1,000,000.00 to begin. Taylor emailed Bud today and the Village received WQIP grant in the amount of 4.5 million (construction money), won't do anything until the WIIA grants are announced. Hoping the trickle down from the infrastructure grant may also help us.

NYSERDA-Village has enough points that we have qualified for a \$5,000.00 grant to be spent on something energy efficient. Ideas so far are changing lights at DPW & ball field to LED, also looking at battery operated equipment. Rob inquired about using it for a heat pump at the Village office. Will get pricing on these ideas. We have a few more things we can do to qualify for \$25,000.00.

FEMA-Last week Homeland Security called and walked us through completing some more forms. DPW has been cleaning up some on Grove Street. Cayuga County water & soil can not do anything until designated by FEMA.

Trustee Reports/Updates

Rob Thurston: Still waiting for a quote on the bath house. Asked about plans for the Roto Salt property and shared some ideas he had for the future of the property. Bud told him that the grant stipulates what can and can't be done.

Bill Boyd: Inquired about getting a new street light on Spring Street near the Academy.

Brian Cornell: He has been emailing with Apple in regard to the ipads and discussing how we are going to set them up. Brian emailed the camera company about cameras on the light poles and has not heard back from them.

O'Hara: Inquired about adding a new street light on Foundry Street, between parking lot and Factory Street as it is very dark. She is working with A&M Graphics on new Village signs to replace the 4 that are up (North end, South end, Spring St.& Center St.), they have been up 20 plus years. Gave examples and pricing of 3 different ones, will ask for a mock up of a couple and go from there. Also looking at benches for historic business district, wondering about the size and how many, passed around pictures of some. Discussed new snowflakes for telephone poles for next year.

Village Attorney's Report: Chad Hayden

Chad told the Board counsel appealed the 2nd circuit to Supreme Courts land in trust decision. Wondering what can the Village do?

Discussed rezoning the North end of the Village to Highway Commercial, this would make it permissible to sell cannabis products there. He presented a draft of the proposed amendment. A motion was made by Mayor

Shattuck, with a second by Trustee Boyd to schedule a Public Hearing at the January meeting to discuss the proposed amendment to the Zoning Law of 2013. All ayes.
