Department of Public Works:

Will schedule Village clean up day for Saturday, April 23, DPW will check into getting the dumpsters. Discussed water licenses that Nick and Joe are working on obtaining and Bob Kneaskern's role with the water department. Have to have 2 licensed operators. Trustee Boyd said he will meet with Bob to discuss as we have to implement a plan.

Received quotes from Dodgers Critter Getters for beaver trapping for, 1 month, 6 months and 12 months. At this time we will just do 1 month and go from there. DPW will get other quotes.

They received quotes for mini excavator and trailer that were sent on to the Board. Decided to order and purchase from John Deere and trailer from Brooks Factory Direct Trailers. Motion made by Trustee Boyd with a 2nd by Trusteee Thurston, all ayes (4-0). Have to pay for the trailer to have upgrade that is included, will do prepay for April.

Code Enforcement Officer Report: Kevin Thurston

Kevin submitted report for 2021 and received email confirming the submission. Has a couple new permits he is working on, including a new pole barn on Hillview Dr. Waiting to get an updated form to begin fire inspections. Biggest issue is that no inspections have been done since 2019.

Mayor's Report: Bud Shattuck

Rezoning Highway Commercial – Told the Board they have to decide what they want to do, want to stay with opt out in regard to cannabis use and sale or proceed with passing Local Law amending Village Zoning Law of 2013 (this would create highway commercial district) and opt in (this would repeal Local Law 8 of 2021 that opted out). We had a second Public Hearing on January 18, 2022 about this (first one was in July 2021 and never voted on so we had to have another).

Motion was made by Trustee Thurston with a second by Trustee O'Hara to vote to amend law, all ayes (4-0). There was a lot of discussion about what to do, each Board Member had a chance to talk. Trustee Cornell arrived at 7:14 pm and was able to join the discussion. A lot of mixed feelings and thoughts about what to do in the best interest of the Village. Voted in favor of establishing highway commercial district and repealing local law 8 of 2021, opting out. Trustee Thurston aye, Trustee O'Hara aye, Mayor Shattuck aye, Trustee Boyd no, and Trustee Cornell no. Passed 3-2. These Local Laws will now be subject to permissive referendum.

MI F Tournament- Will verify dates, discussed a mini festival with band, Bud and Rob will discuss.

Kayak Tournament- We had a request to launch kayaks for a tournament, Bud meeting with Blueway Trail, may look into writing a grant for a floating dock north of Village Office.

ZBA members still needed- only have 2, need at least 3.

ARPA funds- Discussed putting some aside for local business's to apply for \$5,000 grants, Bill and Donna will work on.

Motion made by Trustee Thurston, 2nd by Trustee Cornell to set Public Hearing for budget on April 19, 2022. No Discussion, all ayes.

A local law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Union Springs to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2022 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined by General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Union Springs County of Cayuga is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2022 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

Local Law No. 2 of 2022 Amendments to Village Zoning Law of 2013 With Regard to Retail Sale, Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, and Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of the Village of Union Springs wishes to amend the Village Zoning Law of 2013 to address the effects of Retail Sale, Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, and Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products,

NOW THEREFORE Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Union Springs, that the Village Zoning Law of 2013 is hereby amended as follows:

- I. Section 6-12 USES SUBJECT TO SPECIAL CONDITIONS of Article VI shall be renumbered as Section 6-13 and Section 6-13 MATRIX TABLE OF USE REGULATIONS shall be renumbered as Section 6-14.
- II. There shall be added to Article VI a new Section 6-12 **HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL DISTRICT** as follows:

A. PURPOSE AND INTENT: The purpose and intent in establishing the Highway Commercial (HC) Zoning District is to acknowledge a section of the Village of Union Springs that in addition to traditional commercial uses and enterprises, shall be a zoning district where there will be manufactured or cultivated or sold those goods and services that will serve customers from a wide geographical area, far beyond the Village.

- B. PERMITTED USES: The following uses are permitted by right within the Highway Commercial (HC) Zoning District:
 - (1) All uses permitted by right in the Commercial (C) Zoning District.
- C. SPECIAL USES PERMITTED: The following uses are permitted within the Highway Commercial (HC) Zoning District after Approval of a Special Use Permit by the Village Board and the issuance of such permit by the Zoning Enforcement Officer. Please Refer to Article VIII

for information regarding the procedures for applying for and obtaining a Special Use Permit.

The uses are:

- (1) Automobile Sales & Auto Dealerships
- (2) Automobile or Vehicle Repair
- (3) Gas Station and/or Convenience Store
- (4) Hotel or Motel
- (5) Retail Sale or Dispensing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products. On-site consumption is prohibited.
- (6) Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, or Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products
- D. Pre-existing, non-conforming uses regulated by this Article VI shall be abandoned and discontinued upon the _____th anniversary of the effective date of this amendment.

III. ARTICLE VI ZONING DISTRICT REGULATIONS shall be amended as follows: There shall be added as follows:

To Section 6-1 C. of **AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL (AR) ZONING DISTRICT** Special Uses Permitted - a Paragraph 26 to read as follows:

(26) Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, or Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products

To Section 6-2 C. of **RURAL RESIDENTIAL (RR) ZONING DISTRICT** Special Uses Permitted - a Paragraph 26 to read as follows:

(26) Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, or Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products

To Section 6-6 C. COMMERCIAL (C) ZONING DISTRICT Special Uses Permitted - a Paragraph 12 to read as follows:

(12) Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, or Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis

IV. There shall be added to Section 6-14 MATRIX TABLE OF USE REGULATIONS of the Union Springs Zoning Law an additional line 10A Consumption Sites, Sale or Distribution of Cannabis and Cannabis Products and an additional line 10B Wholesale, Cultivation, Distribution, or Processing of Cannabis and Cannabis Products coded as follows.


